Application Review/Payment/Cancellations/Space Assignments

For an exhibit application to be accepted, the products and services must relate to the educational activity's content. All exhibit applications will be reviewed.

- All applications must be received at least **two weeks prior** to the conference date.
- The exhibit cancellation deadline is eight (8) days prior to the conference date. If written request is received in that time frame, SCLRC will refund the exhibit fee, less a \$500 processing fee.
- Exhibit space will be assigned at the seminar. Space must be occupied by 7:15 a.m.;

CME Guidelines & Exhibit Policies

In compliance with the **ACCME Integrity and Independence in Continuing Education**, arrangements for commercial exhibits or advertisements cannot influence planning or interfere with the presentation, nor can they be a condition of the provision of commercial support for CME activities.

- Exhibit and other promotional fees shall be separate and distinct from educational grants/commercial support.
- All exhibits must be in a room or area separate from the education and the exhibits will not interfere or in any way compete with the learning experience prior to, during, or immediately after the activity.
